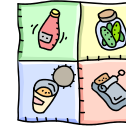

HEALTH KITS & INSTRUCTIONS – Collections will go through May 27th. If you have any questions, please contact Patty Wycuff or Linda Kinser. They will be taken to Lakeside for the conference in June. Please follow these detailed instructions!

Items to Include:

- 1 hand towel 15"x25" to 17"x27" – Kitchen/cleaning & microfiber are not acceptable
 - 1 washcloth
- 1 comb – Needs to be sturdy, No pocket combs or picks please, Rattail combs & combs without handles are acceptable
 - 1 nail clipper
- 1 bath size soap – 3oz & larger sizes only, All brands acceptable, Do not remove from original packaging
 - 1 toothbrush – Adult size only, Please do not remove from original packaging
 - 6 adhesive bandages – 3/4" to 1" size common household band-aids
 - 1 plastic bag one gallon size – Sealable bags only
 - \$1.00 to purchase toothpaste – (separate*)
 - \$1.00 to ship the kit to the final destination – (separate*)

Assembly Directions:

1. Set money for toothpaste & shipping costs aside.
2. Lay out the hand towel flat on a table.
3. Lay the washcloth flat in the center of the hand towel.
4. Place all remaining items on top of the washcloth.
5. Fold over the sides of the hand towel to cover all of the items. Fold up the bottom of the hand towel and then the top so that it covers all of the items.
6. Grasp the bundle of items tightly and roll over the remainder of the hand towel tightly.
 7. Place the tightly rolled bundle in the plastic bag.
 8. Remove as much air as possible and seal the bag shut.

VERY IMPORTANT: DO NOT INCLUDE MONEY FOR TOOTHPASTE & SHIPPING IN THE TOWELS – PLACE THE \$2 IN THE BAG ON TOP OF THE FOLDED ITEMS.

Important Notes:

- All Items must be new
- Do not wash any of the items as they will then be considered used.
- All emergency kits are carefully planned to make them usable in the greatest number of situations. Since strict rules govern product entry into international countries, *it is important that kits contain only requested items – Nothing more.*
- DO NOT include any personal notes, money, or additional material in the kits. Even though you mean well, these things are painstakingly removed and will delay the shipment.

Cost/Value of Health Kit

The value of items purchased to make a health kit is approximately \$13.
(including \$1 for toothpaste & \$1 for shipping)

If you make a quantity of kits – Multiply the number of completed kits by \$2.00 and write a check payable to West Ohio Conference for that amount. Write "UMCOR



Health Kits" in the memo line.
